- OBEDIENCE TRIAL ENTRY FEE: \$24.00 (already includes \$3.50 AKC event fees) for first entry of a dog and \$16.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in an additional obedience class. Pre-Novice class entries are \$16.00.
- RALLY ENTRY FEE: \$24.00 (already includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee) for first entry of a dog and \$16.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in an additional rally class.
- Entry form must include the Agreement section and must be signed at the bottom by the owner or authorized agent; otherwise the entry cannot be accepted.
- NOTICE TO UDX or RAE Class Entrants: those wishing to enter these classes only if their entries are accepted for BOTH Open B/Utility B for obedience or BOTH Advanced B/Excellent B for rally should check the appropriate box. If you are willing to enter only one of these classes if the other is filled should check the individual class boxes. DIRECTIONS

From NORTHWEST -- I-69 exit SR 332 East (Exit 41). From ramp, travel 3 1/3 miles, then turn South (right) at 600 W (there will be a small green sign that says Yorktown). Continue until "T," then turn left and take the next right (Tiger Drive). Continue past the high school and tennis courts to Yorktown Middle School.

From SOUTHWEST -- I-69 exit SR 67 (to 32) (Exit 34). The first road off the exit is SR 67; continue straight past SR 67 traffic light, road curves right, and at stop sign, turn left (East). Continue 6 miles to Yorktown. 2nd traffic light is Tiger Drive (to the North). Turn left and first drive on the right is Yorktown Middle School.

From NORTHEAST or SOUTHEAST - Join the SR 67/35/3 Bypass east of Muncie, take the SR 32 West exit. Note that SR 32 is Jackson Street in Muncie, then becomes Kilgore, then becomes Smith Street in Yorktown.

From MUNCIE MOTEL AREA -- Go West on McGalliard Road (becomes Hwy 332) to 400 W (just after Meijer Store). Turn left (South) on 400 W (also called Nebo Rd.) and continue to Kilgore/Hwy 32. Turn right and continue 1 1/7 miles to Tiger Drive. Turn right and first drive on right is Yorktown Middle School.

· **Telegraph, Telephone, FAX, E-mailed and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

· **No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

· **Entries Cannot Be Accepted, Canceled, Altered or Substituted** after the entries have closed. (See exception on Move-ups.)

· **Declination of Entries.** The Muncie Obedience Training Club, Inc., may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Muncie Obedience Training Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

· **Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

· **Returned Checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The **TRIAL SECRETARY** will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

· **Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, in season, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund or entry fee will be made.

· **Judges Are Not Required to Wait for Dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule.** The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

· **In Accordance with AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows,** no dogs under the age of 6 months are allowed on the show site. All AKC rules apply regarding toys and food in the ring.

· **Exhibitors Must be Governed** by any rules or regulations of civil authorities' building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

· **All Handlers Must Pick Up After Their Dogs.** Anyone witnessed not cleaning up after their dogs will be requested to leave and no refunds given.

GENERAL CONDitions

- All awards are for Regular Classes only unless otherwise specified. Qualifying Scores are required for all prizes offered.
- In case of tie scores for any prize other than those listed under individual classes, a run-off judge will be appointed.
- Where there is a double entry of the same dog only one score will be used for the Special Awards.

· All awards will be given at the Trial. Exhibitors must remain for presentation if eligible for special prizes. In no case will prizes or trophies be mailed.

· All trophies or prizes must be claimed the day of the show or they will become the property of the Muncie Obedience Training Club, Inc.

· "Dog" means either sex.
